Seattle Food Tech is seeking part-time and full-time **plant-based meat production** employees to make SFT's plant-based Crispy Nuggets at our small-scale production kitchen in south Seattle. The production consists of nugget making (mixing, frying, freezing, packaging), and support for the transportation of equipment, supplies, and products to and from our storage facilities. This position requires considerable coordination with other team members and kitchen personnel.

- Comfortable handling and preparing food with a willingness to learn and follow all procedures and protocols.
- Has or is willing to obtain a King County Food Worker Card.
